introduction

You'd have to be living in a cave in Outer Mongolia not to notice how everybody is talking about sex these days. It seems to be the focal point of practically every conversation. Unfortunately, those with the loudest voices hail from Hollywood.

Many of the male characters in today's movies and television shows are depicted as horny guys with stunted personalities, traveling through life with nothing more on their minds than girls—and getting some sexual action. The writers of these sexually charged films and sitcoms build their plots around a simple yet familiar formula: Boy meets Girl, Boy chases Girl, Boy gets Girl in bed, Boy and Girl have lots of fun. Boy and Girl experience no guilt and no consequences as they ride off into the sunset in their azure blue BMW M3 ragtop. Roll the credits.

But in the real world, sex is never quite as simple as the media would have us believe. Hollywood producers love showing us the night of passion, but they conveniently bypass the reality of the morning after: the feelings of remorse, the girl waking up to realize she was nothing more than a convenient object for fulfilling a guy's sexual desire, the visit to a doctor's office because a former sexual partner said it would be a good idea to get checked, or the ominous phone message from a girlfriend who thinks she's pregnant.

So why is the portrayal of sex so far from reality? The fact is, Hollywood—and our sex-crazed culture—has turned its back on God's advice and tried to reverse centuries of

biblical principles. According to Hollywood's credo, being good (like staying out of bed before marriage) is actually bad for you, but being bad (as in indulging in frequent premarital sex) is actually good for you.

Our Creator knew this would happen. Several centuries ago the prophet Isaiah quoted God as saying, "Destruction is certain for those who say that evil is good and good is evil; that dark is light and light is dark; that bitter is sweet and sweet is bitter" (Isaiah 5:20, NLT).

Maybe you've begun to question the truth of the messages you've been hearing. Maybe you suspect that sex is a bit more complicated and dangerous than you realized—either because of personal experience or seeing the impact on your friends. The fact that you are holding this book means that you are at least willing to hear what God has to say about sex, and that's good news, because He sure has a lot to say. He has given us clear direction on everything from how we should treat the opposite sex to how and why we should abstain from sexual activity until marriage.

Keep in mind, though, that God is not some big killjoy in the sky, wanting to put a damper on your attempts at fun. First and foremost, His words are those of a loving Creator who wants to spare His children—you *and* her—the agony that sexual sin can bring. He wants to spare us the emotional pain of the morning after and the physical distress from sexually transmitted diseases that inevitably arise from promiscuous sexual encounters—or that seven-pound "surprise" nine months later. God only wants the best for us, a better future that includes "plans to prosper

you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope,” as His Word states in Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV).

As you will read in the following pages, the Lord of the universe delivers some straight talk about sex that goes against what you’ve been hearing. God doesn’t go for that if-it-feels-good-do-it stuff, nor does He let us make up our minds based on which way today’s cultural winds happen to be blowing. Instead, God’s standard for sexual purity can be captured in a single Bible verse: “But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity” (Ephesians 5:3, NIV).

For young single guys, that verse may prompt some challenging questions. What does a “hint” mean? How far can you go with a girl when you’re alone? How far can you go with yourself when you’re alone?

These are great questions, and you’ll receive some straight answers in *Every Young Man’s Battle Guide*.

God's owner's manual regarding sexual conduct



Let's go to the source and check out what the Bible has to say on the subject of sexual conduct. Did you know that in nearly every book of the New Testament we're commanded to avoid sexual impurity? Here's a selection of passages that teach God's concern for our sexual purity.

GOD'S DEFINITION OF SEXUAL PURITY

Amber is a twenty-year-old single woman attending a Christian college. “I wish I would have been told more specifically what ‘sexual purity’ really meant when I was growing up in the church,” she said. “I was always taught that sexual purity meant ‘no sexual intercourse,’ but then I read and loved the definition given in *Every Man’s Battle*: ‘Sexual purity is receiving no sexual gratification from anything or anyone outside of your husband or wife.’ That’s a black-and-white definition that young people need to be taught. If you don’t do anything else, please stress this definition.”

It is God’s will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable, not in passionate lust like the heathen, who do not know God.

1 THESSALONIANS 4:3–5, NIV

But immorality or any impurity or greed must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints.

EPHESIANS 5:3, NASB

Away then with sinful, earthly things; deaden the evil desires lurking within you; have nothing to do with sexual sin, impurity, lust and shameful desires;

don't worship the good things of life, for that is idolatry.

COLOSSIANS 3:5, TLB

And that means killing off everything connected with that way of death: sexual promiscuity, impurity, lust, doing whatever you feel like whenever you feel like it, and grabbing whatever attracts your fancy. That's a life shaped by things and feelings instead of by God.

COLOSSIANS 3:5, MSG

What I meant was that you are not to keep company with anyone who claims to be a ... Christian but indulges in sexual sins.... Don't even eat lunch with such a person.

1 CORINTHIANS 5:11, TLB

RUN—DON'T WALK—AWAY FROM SEXUAL IMMORALITY

I appeal to you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may prove what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

ROMANS 12:1-2, RSV

Run away from sexual sin! No other sin so clearly affects the body as this one does. For sexual immorality is a sin against your own body.

1 CORINTHIANS 6:18, NLT

For if you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

ROMANS 8:13, NASB

Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, do; and the God of peace will be with you.

PHILIPPIANS 4:8-9, RSV

But if you give yourself to the Lord, you and Christ are joined together as one person.

That is why I say to run from sex sin. No other sin affects the body as this one does. When you sin this sin it is against your own body.

1 CORINTHIANS 6:17-18, TLB

As for the Gentile Christians, all we ask of them is what we already told them in a letter:... they should stay away from all sexual immorality.

ACTS 21:25, NLT

Abstain ... from sexual immorality.

ACTS 15:20, NIV

Beloved, I implore you as aliens and strangers and exiles [in this world] to abstain from the sensual urges (the evil desires, the passions of the flesh, your lower nature) that wage war against the soul. [Live] as free people, [yet] without employing your freedom as a pretext for wickedness; but [live at all times] as servants of God.

1 PETER 2:11,16, AMP

You are to abstain from ... sexual immorality.

ACTS 15:29, NIV

See that no one is sexually immoral.

HEBREWS 12:16, NIV

WHAT THE BIBLE HAS TO SAY ABOUT HOMOSEXUALITY

Do not practice homosexuality; it is a detestable sin.

LEVITICUS 18:22, NLT

Don't you know that those who do wrong will have no share in the Kingdom of God? Don't fool yourselves. Those who indulge in sexual sin, who are idol worshipers, adulterers, male prostitutes, homosexuals ... none of these will have a share in the Kingdom of God.

1 CORINTHIANS 6:9-10, NLT

In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed indecent acts with other men, and received in themselves the due penalty for their perversion.

ROMANS 1:27, NIV

WHAT JESUS SAID ABOUT LUST

But don't think you've preserved your virtue simply by staying out of bed. Your heart can be corrupted by lust even quicker than your body. Those leering looks you think nobody notices—they also corrupt. Let's not pretend this is easier than it really is. If you want to live a morally pure life, here's what you have to do: You have to blind your right eye the moment you catch it in a lustful leer. You have to choose to live one-eyed or else be dumped on a moral trash pile.

MATTHEW 5:28-29, MSG

EXAMINE YOUR THOUGHT LIFE FREQUENTLY

Turn your back on the turbulent desires of youth and give your positive attention to goodness, integrity, love, and peace.

TIMOTHY 2:22, PHILLIPS

Don't allow love to turn into lust, setting off a downhill slide into sexual promiscuity, filthy practices, or bullying greed.

EPHESIANS 5:3, MSG

Remember all the commands of the LORD, that you may obey them and not prostitute yourselves by going after the lusts of your own hearts and eyes.

NUMBERS 15:39, NIV

Lust not after her beauty in thine heart; neither let her take thee with her eyelids.

PROVERBS 6:25, KJV

You have heard that the law of Moses says, “Do not commit adultery.” But I say, anyone who even looks at a woman with lust in his eye has already committed adultery with her in his heart. So if your eye—even if it is your good eye—causes you to lust, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. And if your hand—even if it is your stronger hand—causes you to sin, cut it off

and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell.

MATTHEW 5:27-30, NLT

For God has not called us to be dirty-minded and full of lust, but to be holy and clean. If anyone refuses to live by these rules he is not disobeying the rules of men but of God who gives his Holy Spirit to you.

1 THESSALONIANS 4:7-8, TLB

For they mouth empty, boastful words and, by appealing to the lustful desires of sinful human nature, they entice people who are just escaping from those who live in error.

2 PETER 2:18, NIV

But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly. For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number sleep. But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world.

1 CORINTHIANS 11:28-32, NASB

For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the

Father but is of the world.

1 JOHN 2:16, NKJV

TODAY'S CHOICES WILL AFFECT YOU TOMORROW

Let's say you do something stupid, like stick your hand into a fire. If you leave your hand in the flames long enough, you'll feel the immediate consequences of excruciating pain. An even dumber action, however, would be to think that you're different and stronger than everyone else, believing you can put your hand in a campfire and not be burned. Since everyone knows that fire's consequences are instantaneous, few men play with fire.

Sin has a different timetable, however. You might sin for years and never experience the consequences, but they will come.

That is why God let go of them and let them do all these evil things, so that even their women turned against God's natural plan for them and indulged in sex sin with each other. And the men, instead of having a normal sex relationship with women, burned with lust for each other, men doing shameful things with other men and, as a result, getting paid within their own souls with the penalty they so richly deserved.

ROMANS 1:26-28, TLB

They don't care anymore about right and wrong and have given themselves over to impure ways. They stop at nothing, being driven by their evil minds and reckless lusts.

EPHESIANS 4:19, TLB

For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.

MATTHEW 15:19, NIV

Stop acting so proud and haughty!
Don't speak with such arrogance!
The LORD is a God who knows your deeds;
and he will judge you for what you have done.

1 SAMUEL 2:3, NLT

Even a child is known by his deeds,
Whether what he does is pure and right.

PROVERBS 20:11, NKJV

I said to myself, "In due season God will judge everything man does, both good and bad."

ECCLESIASTES 3:17, TLB

I am afraid that when I come again my God may humiliate me before you, and I may mourn over many of those who have sinned in the past and not repented of the impurity, immorality and sensuality which they have practiced.

2 CORINTHIANS 12:21, NASB

You can be sure that no immoral, impure, or greedy person will inherit the Kingdom of Christ and of

God. For a greedy person is really an idolater who worships the things of this world.

EPHESIANS 5:5, NLT

What comes out of a man is what makes him “unclean.” For from within, out of men’s hearts, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, [and] adultery.

MARK 7:20–21, NIV

When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, your lives will produce these evil results: sexual immorality, impure thoughts, eagerness for lustful pleasure, idolatry, participation in demonic activities, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, divisions, the feeling that everyone is wrong except those in your own little group, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other kinds of sin. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

GALATIANS 5:19–21, NLT

So put to death the sinful, earthly things lurking within you. Have nothing to do with sexual sin, impurity, lust, and shameful desires. Don’t be greedy for the good things of this life, for that is idolatry. God’s terrible anger will come upon those who do such things.

COLOSSIANS 3:5–6, NLT

Don't you know that those who do wrong will have no share in the Kingdom of God? Don't fool yourselves. Those who indulge in sexual sin, who are idol worshipers, adulterers, male prostitutes, homosexuals, thieves, greedy people, drunkards, abusers, and swindlers—none of these will have a share in the Kingdom of God.... But our bodies were not made for sexual immorality. They were made for the Lord, and the Lord cares about our bodies.... Run away from sexual sin!

1 CORINTHIANS 6:9-10,13,18, NLT

There's more to sex than mere skin on skin. Sex is as much spiritual mystery as physical fact. As written in Scripture, "The two become one." Since we want to become spiritually one with the Master, we must not pursue the kind of sex that avoids commitment and intimacy, leaving us more lonely than ever—the kind of sex that can never "become one."

1 CORINTHIANS 6:16, MSG

WHAT GOD DESIRES FOR YOU

For God wants you to be holy and pure, and to keep clear of all sexual sin so that each of you will marry in holiness and honor—not in lustful passion as the heathen do, in their ignorance of God and his ways. ... For God has not called us to be dirty-minded and full of lust, but to be holy and clean.

1 THESSALONIANS 4:3–5,7, TLB

But you are not in darkness, brethren, for that day to surprise you like a thief. For you are all sons of light and sons of the day; we are not of the night or of darkness. So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober. For those who sleep sleep at night, and those who get drunk are drunk at night. But, since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation.

1 THESSALONIANS 5:4–8, RSV

Evil plans are an abomination to the LORD,
But pleasant words are pure.

PROVERBS 15:26, NASB

The LORD hates people with twisted hearts, but he delights in those who have integrity.

You can be sure that evil people will be punished,
but the children of the godly will go free.

PROVERBS 11:20–21, NLT

How can a young person stay pure?

By obeying your word and following its rules.

PSALM 119:9, NLT

For God has not called us to impurity but to consecration

[to dedicate ourselves to the most thorough purity].

1 THESSALONIANS 4:7, AMP

SET BOUNDARIES FOR YOURSELF

If you don't ram a stake into the ground and declare, "This is as far as I go, and I won't go any further," then you'll lose your footing on the slippery slope of sex. It's amazing how easily we can make sweeping rationalizations for our behavior:

- "It's okay because I really love her. I *know* I'm going to marry her anyway."
- "Why wait until marriage? We're already married in our hearts."
- "Sex isn't wrong for everyone. God is really concerned only about adultery."

Maybe you've said the same things to yourself ... the same things that non-Christians say to themselves! That alone should make you feel a bit uncomfortable.

Because we have these promises, dear friends, let us cleanse ourselves from everything that can defile our body or spirit. And let us work toward complete purity because we fear God.

2 CORINTHIANS 7:1, NLT

As I said when I left for Macedonia, please stay there in Ephesus and try to stop the men who are teaching such wrong doctrine. Put an end to their myths and fables, and their idea of being saved by finding favor with an endless chain of angels leading up to God—wild ideas that stir up questions and arguments

instead of helping people accept God's plan of faith. What I am eager for is that all the Christians there will be filled with love that comes from pure hearts, and that their minds will be clean and their faith strong.

1 TIMOTHY 1:3-5, TLB

Do not lay hands on anyone hastily, nor share in other people's sins; keep yourself pure.

1 TIMOTHY 5:22, NKJV

Yes, dear friends, we are already God's children, and we can't even imagine what we will be like when Christ returns. But we do know that when he comes we will be like him, for we will see him as he really is. And all who believe this will keep themselves pure, just as Christ is pure.

1 JOHN 3:2-3, NLT

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

YOUR BODY IS A TEMPLE

Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

1 CORINTHIANS 3:16, NASB

Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I therefore take the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? Never! Do you not know that he who joins himself to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For, as it is written, "The two shall become one." But he who is united to the Lord becomes one spirit with him.... Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God? You are not your own; you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

There is a sense in which sexual sins are different from all others. In sexual sin we violate the sacredness of our own bodies, these bodies that were made for God-given and God-modeled love, for "becoming one" with another. Or didn't you realize that your body is a sacred place, the place of the Holy Spirit? Don't you see that you can't live however you please, squandering what God paid such a high price for? The physical part of you is not some piece of property belonging to the spiritual part of you. God owns the whole works. So let people see God in and through your body.

1 CORINTHIANS 6:18-20, MSG

YOU ARE PART OF SOMETHING BIGGER

Your body has many parts—limbs, organs, cells—but no matter how many parts you can name, you're still one body. It's exactly the same with Christ. By means of his one Spirit, we all said goodbye to our partial and piecemeal lives. We each used to independently call our own shots, but then we entered into a large and integrated life in which he has the final say in everything. (This is what we proclaimed in word and action when we were baptized.) Each of us is now a part of his resurrection body, refreshed and sustained at one fountain—his Spirit—where we all come to drink. The old labels we once used to identify ourselves—labels like Jew or Greek, slave or free—are no longer useful. We need something larger, more comprehensive.

I want you to think about how all this makes you more significant, not less. A body isn't just a single part blown up into something huge. It's all the different-but-similar parts arranged and functioning together. If Foot said, "I'm not elegant like Hand, embellished with rings; I guess I don't belong to this body," would that make it so? If Ear said, "I'm not beautiful like Eye, limpid and expressive; I don't deserve a place on the head," would you want to remove it from the body? If the body was all eye, how could it hear? If all ear, how could it smell? As

it is, we see that God has carefully placed each part of the body right where he wanted it.

But I also want you to think about how this keeps your significance from getting blown up into self-importance. For no matter how significant you are, it is only because of what you are a part of. An enormous eye or a gigantic hand wouldn't be a body, but a monster. What we have is one body with many parts, each its proper size and in its proper place. No part is important on its own. Can you imagine Eye telling Hand, "Get lost; I don't need you"? Or, Head telling Foot, "You're fired; your job has been phased out"? As a matter of fact, in practice it works the other way—the "lower" the part, the more basic, and therefore necessary. You can live without an eye, for instance, but not without a stomach. When it's a part of your own body you are concerned with, it makes no difference whether the part is visible or clothed, higher or lower. You give it dignity and honor just as it is, without comparisons. If anything, you have more concern for the lower parts than the higher. If you had to choose, wouldn't you prefer good digestion to full-bodied hair?

The way God designed our bodies is a model for understanding our lives together as a church: every part dependent on every other part, the parts we mention and the parts we don't, the parts we see and the parts we don't. If one part hurts, every other part is involved in the hurt, and in the healing. If one part flourishes, every other part enters into the

exuberance.

You are Christ's body—that's who you are! You must never forget this. Only as you accept your part of that body does your "part" mean anything.

1 CORINTHIANS 12:12-27, MSG

THE BOTTOM LINE ON WHAT'S OUT OF BOUNDS

The LORD said to Moses, “Speak to the Israelites and say to them: ‘I am the LORD your God. You must not do as they do in Egypt, where you used to live, and you must not do as they do in the land of Canaan, where I am bringing you. Do not follow their practices. You must obey my laws and be careful to follow my decrees. I am the LORD your God. Keep my decrees and laws, for the man who obeys them will live by them. I am the LORD.

“ ‘Do not have sexual relations with both a woman and her daughter. Do not have sexual relations with either her son’s daughter or her daughter’s daughter; they are her close relatives. That is wickedness.

“ ‘Do not take your wife’s sister as a rival wife and have sexual relations with her while your wife is living.

“ ‘Do not approach a woman to have sexual relations during the uncleanness of her monthly period.

“ ‘Do not have sexual relations with your neighbor’s wife and defile yourself with her.

“ ‘Do not give any of your children to be sacrificed to Molech, for you must not profane the name of your God. I am the LORD.

“ ‘Do not lie with a man as one lies with a woman; that is detestable.

“ ‘Do not have sexual relations with an animal and defile yourself with it. A woman must not present herself to an animal to have sexual relations with it;

that is a perversion.

“ ‘Do not defile yourselves in any of these ways, because this is how the nations that I am going to drive out before you became defiled. SHOW REAL LOVE FOR HER

Teenage guys often try to justify sex outside of marriage, saying, “But we love each other! That’s why it felt so right for us to sleep together!” But true love for your neighbor (or your girlfriend) can only exist and can only be expressed through obedience to God’s standards. Anything less is counterfeit love.

Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves the father loves his child as well. This is how we know that we love the children of God [in this case, your girlfriend]: by loving God and carrying out his commands.

DON'T TRY TO PUSH PAST HER BOUNDARIES

In the days of the prophet Ezekiel, God's people—Israel—had strayed again, committing “adultery” against Him by chasing other gods. The Lord sought a metaphor that He could use through Ezekiel that could help us understand the depth of their sin and would express to His people how deeply they had hurt Him. He wanted to find something that was clearly despicable and clearly wrong to which to compare this sin. He chose premarital petting, or groping, as the comparison, clearly revealing His thoughts and attitudes about the topic: petting is just as bad as choosing other gods over Him!

In that land their breasts were fondled and their virgin bosoms caressed.

EZEKIEL 23:3, NIV

When you push past your girlfriend's sexual boundaries and standards, you break Christian unity with her. You also break unity with God.

If your [girlfriend] is distressed because of what you [ask her to do sexually], you are no longer acting in love. Do not by your [sexual requests] destroy your [girlfriend] for whom Christ died.... For the kingdom of God is not a matter of [parking or groping or pushing past your girlfriend's boundaries], but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit, because anyone who serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and approved by men.

Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification [unity in Christ]. Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of [parking or groping or pushing past your girlfriend's boundaries].

EVALUATE YOUR DEFINITION OF BEAUTY

A story from Fred Stoeker:

“Amy, seventeen years old, exclaimed, ‘I just finished your book *Every Young Man’s Battle*. Wow! I had no idea how much what I do and what I wear affects the young men around me. I have always had high standards for modest clothes, but now they will be even higher.’

“Although it’s natural to be distracted and even attracted by a young woman in revealing clothes, the Bible tells us that true beauty comes from a pure heart. Amy’s amazing response, her desire to respect those around her, reflects the kind of beauty that endures. What kind of woman will attract your attention: one who flaunts her body to every guy who walks by or one who chooses to focus on inner beauty and to reserve her body solely for her husband?

“Reexamine your definitions of beauty, and let your girlfriend know that you appreciate her helping you toward purity by dressing modestly.”

And I want women to be modest in their appearance. They should wear decent and appropriate clothing and not draw attention to themselves by the way they fix their hair or by wearing gold or pearls or expensive clothes. For women who claim to be devoted to God should make themselves attractive by the good things they do.

[Addressed to women] Don’t be concerned about the outward beauty that depends on jewelry, or beautiful

GOD PURPOSEFULLY RESERVED SEX FOR MARRIAGE

A story from a young woman:

“When we started dating fourteen months ago, everything was perfect. I felt I’d finally met a great Christian guy who loved my family and agreed with my morals. But six months ago, we slept together. We were both virgins and, to tell you the truth, I didn’t want to do it. I had struggled through many relationships before and had remained pure. I was so wanting to wait for my wedding night, but I also wanted to make him happy, so I let it go too far.

“Since then, life has been terrible. I knew that getting it on was a mistake and a sin before I even did it, but the experience really hit him hard too. Now every other area of his life has been impacted. He doesn’t think looking at pornography is wrong, he doesn’t think cursing is wrong, he doesn’t think premarital sex is wrong, and he doesn’t even honor his parents or mine anymore. We were thinking about getting married after college, but now I don’t know what to do. He views everything I say as ‘nagging.’ I just want the same godly man back that I grew to love. I guess I don’t want to face the fact that this man that I gave myself to is not the one who God has planned for me to marry.”

Is it a good thing to have sexual relations?

Certainly—but only within a certain context. It’s good for a man to have a wife, and for a woman to have a husband. Sexual drives are strong, but

marriage is strong enough to contain them and provide for a balanced and fulfilling sexual life in a world of sexual disorder. The marriage bed must be a place of mutuality—the husband seeking to satisfy his wife, the wife seeking to satisfy her husband. Marriage is not a place to “stand up for your rights.” Marriage is a decision to serve the other, whether in bed or out.

THE ADVANTAGES OF BEING SINGLE

The time and energy that married people spend on caring for and nurturing each other, the unmarried can spend in becoming whole and holy instruments of God. I'm trying to be helpful and make it as easy as possible for you, not making things harder. All I want is for you to be able to develop a way of life in which you can spend plenty of time together with the Master without a lot of distractions.

EVERY CHOICE HAS A CONSEQUENCE

It's critical to recognize visual sexual impurity as foreplay. If viewing sensual things merely provides a flutter of appreciation for a woman's beauty, it would be no different than viewing the awesome power of a thunderstorm racing over the Iowa cornfields. There would be no sin and no problem.

But if it is foreplay, and you *are* getting sexual gratification, then it defiles your body and your relationships. And it's certain that you'll be paying a cost that you may not even be aware of.

When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, your lives will produce these evil results: sexual immorality, impure thoughts, eagerness for lustful pleasure, idolatry, participation in demonic activities, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, divisions, the feeling that everyone is wrong except those in your own little group, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other kinds of sin. Let me tell you again ... that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

GALATIANS 5:16-21, NLT

FREEDOM COMES WITH RESPONSIBILITY

A lot of us talk a good game about purity while sitting on the bench (or sitting in church), but when given the chance to play, we keep our eyes on the babes in the stands, not on the pitcher holding the ball.

If you aren't trustworthy in handling fleshly passions, how can you be trusted to handle things of greater value?

Be careful with this freedom of yours. Do not cause a brother or sister with a weaker conscience to stumble.

It is obvious what kind of life develops out of trying to get your own way all the time: repetitive, loveless, cheap sex; a stinking accumulation of mental and emotional garbage; frenzied and joyless grabs for happiness; trinket gods; magic-show religion; paranoid loneliness; cutthroat competition; all-consuming-yet-never-satisfied wants; a brutal temper; an impotence to love or be loved; divided homes and divided lives; small-minded and lopsided pursuits; the vicious habit of depersonalizing everyone into a rival; uncontrolled and uncontrollable addictions; ugly parodies of community. I could go on.

This isn't the first time I have warned you, you know. If you use your freedom this way, you will not inherit God's kingdom.

WHAT'S MORE IMPORTANT, PURITY OR PLEASURE?

James, a respected teen in his youth group, refused to promise to stay sexually pure when pressed to do so. "There are too many unforeseen situations out there for me to make such a promise," he said. Translation: "I want to keep my options open."

James has stopped short. Have you?

PURITY STARTS IN THE MIND

You can feel a new light and lightness in your soul when you turn from sexual sin. Along with inner peace comes an outer peace that will affect your daily life.

But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly.

LUKE 21:34, NKJV

And now a personal but most urgent matter; I write in the gentle but firm spirit of Christ. I hear that I'm being painted as cringing and wishy-washy when I'm with you, but harsh and demanding when at a safe distance writing letters. Please don't force me to take a hard line when I'm present with you. Don't think that I'll hesitate a single minute to stand up to those who say I'm an unprincipled opportunist. Then they'll have to eat their words.

The world is unprincipled. It's dog-eat-dog out there! The world doesn't fight fair. But we don't live or fight our battles that way—never have and never will. The tools of our trade aren't for marketing or manipulation, but they are for demolishing that entire massively corrupt culture. We use our

powerful God-tools for smashing warped philosophies, tearing down barriers erected against the truth of God, fitting every loose thought and emotion and impulse into the structure of life shaped by Christ. Our tools are ready at hand for clearing the ground of every obstruction and building lives of obedience into maturity.

2 CORINTHIANS 10:1-11, MSG

So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, with a continual lust for more.

You, however, did not come to know Christ that way. Surely you heard of him and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

EPHESIANS 4:17-24, NIV

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your

requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

PHILIPPIANS 4:6-8, NKJV

And so, dear brothers and sisters who belong to God and are bound for heaven, think about this Jesus whom we declare to be God's Messenger and High Priest.

HEBREWS 3:1, NLT

Keep your eyes on Jesus, our leader and instructor. He was willing to die a shameful death on the cross because of the joy he knew would be his afterwards; and now he sits in the place of honor by the throne of God. While understanding that His standard of purity doesn’t come naturally to us, He still calls us to rise up, by the power of His indwelling presence, to get the job done.

Before an important battle for the army he commanded, Joab said to the troops of Israel, “Be of good courage, and let us play the men for our people” (2 Samuel 10:12, KJV). In short, he was saying, “We know God’s plan for us. Let’s rise up as men, and set our hearts and minds to get it done!”

In the realm of sexual integrity, God wants you to rise up and get it done.

THE COMMAND TO BREAK FREE

We have power through the Lord to overcome every level of sexual immorality, but if we don't utilize that power, we'll never break free of the habit.

THE COMMAND TO CHOOSE MANHOOD

2 PETER 3:11, NLT

Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.

THE COMMAND TO COURAGEOUSLY TAKE HOLD OF GOD'S PROVISION

It's like the situation facing Joshua and the people of Israel as they prepared to cross the Jordan River and possess the Promised Land. What did God say to Joshua?

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, *for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go*” (Joshua 1:9, [NIV, emphasis added]).

He'd given the Israelites all they needed. They merely had to cross the river.

Regarding sexual purity, God knows the provision He's made for us. We aren't short on power or authority, but what we lack is *urgency*. We must choose to be strong and courageous to walk into purity. In the millisecond it takes to make that choice, the Holy Spirit will start guiding you and walking through the struggle with you.

Finally, dear brothers and sisters, we urge you in the name of the Lord Jesus to live in a way that pleases God, as we have taught you. You are doing this already, and we encourage you to do so more and more.

We want a man we can trust and deeply respect.”

Let me say this, then, speaking for the Lord: Live no longer as the unsaved do, for they are blinded and confused. Their closed hearts are full of darkness; they are far away from the life of God because they have shut their minds against him, and they cannot understand his ways. For as you know him better, he will give you, through his great power, everything you need for living a truly good life: he even shares his own glory and his own goodness with us! And by that same mighty power he has given us all the other rich and wonderful blessings he promised; for instance, the promise to save us from the lust and rottenness all around us, and to give us his own character.

But to obtain these gifts, you need more than faith; you must also work hard to be good, and even that is not enough. For then you must learn to know God better and discover what he wants you to do. Next, learn to put aside your own desires so that you will become patient and godly, gladly letting God have his way with you. This will make possible the next step, which is for you to enjoy other people and to like them, and finally you will grow to love them deeply. The more you go on in this way, the more you will grow strong spiritually and become fruitful and useful to our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 PETER 1:3-8, TLB

Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed.

I’m choosing to live purely!”

At a single moment, salvation gave us a new life and a new desire to be sexually pure for the first time. But this new desire alone will not bring full intimacy with Christ. We must say yes to this new desire and refuse to ignore it. We must choose oneness and intimacy with Christ. We must choose sexual purity.

Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock:... the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall.

MATTHEW 7:24,25, NKJV

But if you do not obey the LORD, and if you rebel against his commands, his hand will be against you, as it was against your fathers.

1 SAMUEL 12:15, NIV

In God's kingdom, Old Testament or New Testament, choosing obedience has always been central to intimacy with God. Trouble is, we aren't in search of obedience. We're in search of mere excellence, and His command is *not* enough. We push back, responding, "Why should I eliminate every hint? That's too hard!"

We have countless churches filled with countless men encumbered by sexual sin, weakened by low-grade sexual

fevers—men happy enough to go to Promise Keepers but too sickly to *be* promise keepers.

A spiritual battle for purity is going on in every heart and soul. The costs are real. Obedience is hard, requiring humility and meekness, very rare elements indeed.

the basics of planning for battle



For teens and young adults, sexual gratification comes from three places: the eyes, the mind, and the body. Therefore, as in any war, you must blockade the “shipping lanes” of the eyes and mind that drive you toward sexual sin and that keep your enemy strong. Beyond that, you must also make sure that you have healthy, positive affections and attitudes in your relationships with girls. In other words, you want your heart to be right and your boundaries clear. To accomplish this, you need to build three perimeters of defense into your life:

You need to build a line of defense with your *eyes*.

You need to build a line of defense in your *mind*.

You need to build a line of defense in your *heart*. Think of the first line of defense—your eyes—as a wall with “Keep Out” signs around it. You defend your eyes by training them to “bounce” from anything sensual.

The second line of defense is your mind. With the mind, you necessarily block out the objects of lust, but you do evaluate and capture them. A key support verse is 2 Corinthians 10:5: “We take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ” [NIV]. You must train your mind to take thoughts captive, something your mind probably hasn’t been inclined to do.

Your third line of defense is your heart. This innermost defense perimeter is built by strengthening the authenticity

of your Christian love for the girls you date, as well as increasing your commitment to become a blessing to others. You want to honor and cherish every young woman you date, just as you hope that the guy dating your future wife is honoring and cherishing her.

Given that Jesus is sinless, then it is true that Jesus not only never touched a woman with dishonor, He never even *looked* at a woman in dishonor. In this arena, Jesus is clearly our role model.

Christ, who suffered for you, is your example. Follow in his steps: He never sinned, never told a lie, never answered back when insulted.... He personally carried the load of our sins in his own body when he died on the cross, so that we can be finished with sin and live a good life from now on. For his wounds have healed ours!

There is no one on earth like him; he is blameless and upright, a man who fears God and shuns evil” (Job 1:8, NIV).

Was God proud of Job? You bet! He applauded His servant’s faithfulness in words of highest praise, and we should seek that same praise as well.

We've known those who have failed in their battle for sexual purity, and we know some who have won. The difference? Those who won hated their impurity. They were going to war and were going to win—or die trying. Every resource was leveled upon the foe.

But I say, walk and live [habitually] in the [Holy] Spirit [responsive to and controlled and guided by the Spirit]; then you will certainly not gratify the cravings and desires of the flesh (of human nature without God).

GALATIANS 5:16, AMP

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

PRAYER

When we pray, we aren't praying that He will decide to help us. He has already decided to help us. We are praying so that our hearts will change.

For what great nation is there who has a god so near to them as the Lord our God is to us in all things for which we call upon Him?

DEUTERONOMY 4:7, AMP

Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.

ROMANS 12:12, NIV

Pray then like this:
Our Father who art in heaven,
Hallowed be thy name ...
Lead us not into temptation,
But deliver us from evil.

MATTHEW 6:9,13, RSV

Garrett, a Bible college sophomore, said, "I used to get lustful thoughts popping up all the time during prayer. But now that my eyes are protected, it doesn't happen, so prayer has become much deeper and uninterrupted."

WORSHIP

What helps bring true intimacy with God quickly? Worship. We were created to worship. Worship and praise brings intimacy with the Lord and ushers us quickly into His presence.

Chuck Swindoll once mentioned on his *Insight for Living* radio broadcast that he never enters prayer without first entering worship. That's a good place to start. You can memorize a few choruses and hymns and sing them softly to the Lord before beginning prayer.

Then if people speak evil against you, they will be ashamed when they see what a good life you live because you belong to Christ. Remember, it is better to suffer for doing good, if that is what God wants, than to suffer for doing wrong!

YOUR SWORD

You'll need a good Bible verse to use as a sword and rallying point.

Just one? It may be useful to memorize several verses of Scripture about purity since they work to eventually transform and wash the mind. But in the cold-turkey, day-to-day fight against impurity, having several memory verses might be as cumbersome as strapping on a hundred-pound backpack to engage in hand-to-hand combat. That's why we recommend a single "attack verse," and we suggest the opening line of Job 31: "I [have] made a covenant with my eyes" [NIV].

When you fail and look longer than necessary at a hot babe, sharply say, "No, I've made a covenant with my eyes. I can't do that!" When you're tempted to let your gaze linger on a beautiful woman with a low-cut dress, say, "No, I've made a covenant with my eyes. I can't do that!" This action will be a quick dagger to the heart of your enemy.

YOUR SHIELD

Your shield—a protective verse that you can reflect on and draw strength from even when you aren't in the direct line of fire—may be even more important than your sword because it places temptation out of earshot. We suggest selecting this verse as your shield: “Flee from sexual immorality.... You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your body” (1 Corinthians 6:18–20, NIV).

It also helps to repeat this when facing sensual images or thoughts: “I have no right to look at that or think about it. I haven't the authority.”

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.

While you build real interpersonal intimacy into your life by joining an accountability group, don't forget to place God in the center of the equation. By seeking and asking Him for supernatural help in this battle, you can overcome things that you never thought possible. You'll find yourself hungrier to know Him, and you'll experience a greater desire to communicate with Him. As your intimacy with God grows, you'll need less of that false intimacy. You'll find Him to be your best accountability partner.

WE ARE ACCOUNTABLE TO GOD

What then shall I do when God rises up?

When he makes inquiry, what shall I answer him?

Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up Your hand.

Do not forget the afflicted.

Honest sharing must occur in these relationships. Tough questions must be asked, and true answers given. Otherwise, you don't have an accountability group at all, but merely a sympathy gathering where each person admits his failure again and again, week after week.

Use every piece of God's armor to resist the enemy in the time of evil, so that after the battle you will

still be standing firm. Stand your ground, putting on the sturdy belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News, so that you will be fully prepared. In every battle you will need faith as your shield to stop the fiery arrows aimed at you by Satan. Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Pray at all times and on every occasion in the power of the Holy Spirit. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all Christians everywhere.

But Jesus replied, “It is written in the Scriptures, ‘Other things in life are much more important than bread!’ ”

Then Satan took him up and revealed to him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time; and the devil told him, “I will give you all these splendid kingdoms and their glory—for they are mine to give to anyone I wish—if you will only get down on your knees and worship me.”

But three days later ... two of Dinah's brothers, Simeon and Levi, took their swords, entered the town without opposition, and slaughtered every man there, including Hamor and Shechem. They rescued Dinah from Shechem's house and returned to their camp. Then all of Jacob's sons plundered the town because their sister had been defiled there. They seized all the flocks and herds and donkeys—everything they could lay their hands on, both inside the town and outside in the fields.

GENESIS 34:1–2,5,7,25–28, NLT

In a similar way, Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding towns gave themselves up to sexual immorality and perversion. They serve as an example of those who suffer the punishment of eternal fire.

I was looking out the window of my house one day and saw a simpleminded young man who lacked common sense. He was crossing the street near the house of an immoral woman. He was strolling down the path by her house at twilight, as the day was fading, as the dark of night set in. The woman approached him, dressed seductively and sly of heart. She was the brash, rebellious type who never stays at home. She is often seen in the streets and markets, soliciting at every corner.

She threw her arms around him and kissed him, and with a brazen look she said, "I've offered my sacrifices and just finished my vows. It's you I was looking for! I came out to find you, and here you are! My bed is spread with colored sheets of finest linen imported from Egypt. I've perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon. Come, let's drink our fill of love until morning. Let's enjoy each other's caresses, for my husband is not home. He's away on a long trip. He has taken a wallet full of money with him, and he won't return until later in the month."

So she seduced him with her pretty speech. With her flattery she enticed him. He followed her at once, like an ox going to the slaughter or like a trapped stag, awaiting the arrow that would pierce its heart. He was like a bird flying into a snare, little knowing it would cost him his life.

Without His presence, we have little hope of overcoming the pressures of the world. Now is the perfect time to examine your heart and be sure that you have truly entrusted your heart and life to God, guaranteeing for yourself a Companion who will fight with you and for you.

In Scripture, the “Roman Road” teaches us that everyone has sinned (Romans 3:23), the penalty for our sin is death (Romans 6:23), Jesus Christ died for our sins (Romans 5:8), and to be forgiven for our sins, we must believe and confess that Jesus is Lord, because salvation comes only through Jesus Christ (Romans 10:8–10).

Have you walked the truths of the Roman Road? If not, you can come to know Christ right now by reading and confessing this set of verses. When you trust in Christ, you will spend eternity with Him.

THE ROMAN ROAD

Salvation that comes from trusting Christ—which is the message we preach—is already within easy reach. In fact, the Scriptures say, “The message is close at hand; it is on your lips and in your heart.”

For if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.
